

 - ONE: Some days we are quick to trust your blessings—

- ONE: Other days, our praise falls silent and doubt creeps in.
- MANY: Forgive us for losing sight of ourselves.
 - ONE: We know that fear and doubt are part of the journey of faith. But for the days when we are far from you and far from ourselves, we ask for your tender grace.
- MANY: Pull us closer toward you. Remind us of the mountaintop moments of our faith. Amen.

We pause for a moment of silent, personal confession.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

ONE: Friends, whether you speak to God in a whisper or with clear conviction, with questions or with answers, with hope in your heart or with doubt in your throat—God will always listen with love and mercy.
