When I miss the snow – which I do – I reach back to a memory of sledding down the huge hill in the neighborhood where I spent my earliest years. The scary thrill of coming down that steep slope at a high rate of speed was offset by the loving embrace of my father's arms, as he sat snuggled in behind me, never letting go.

For me, that is a wonderfully comforting image of the many ways in which God holds on to us when the going gets rough. 


